Adopt -a-Family

InnVision needs donors to adopt the 150 families that will register with our program. Be a donor and fulfill a wish list from one of our families. You shop and wrap the gifts for distribution to the family. Depending on the family size, the cost can range from \$200-\$500 worth of gifts. This is a great opportunity for group giving.
